Standing Business and Reports

- Barb Oakleaf proposed that the FCDP sponsor a speaker forum for individuals who are working on literacy issues in Fremont County. Committee members to plan this event are Barb Oakleaf, Chessie Lee and Maureen Donohoue. An ad will be placed on the FCDP website inviting all interested Dems and citizens-at-large to participate in the planning of the event. The committee will report the game plan to the rest of the group at the next meeting.

Old Business:

<u>FCDP picnic-</u> The picnic in August was at the Haper's home and was attended by 35 people. It was felt that it was a very worthwhile event.

<u>September State Central Committee meeting report-</u> Mary and Rod Haper attended the SCC meeting and reported that 50 statewide Dems attended. The state party will assist the county parties as they develop their strategic plans, goals and timelines. The state party will conduct training on fund raising, candidate recruitment, voter registration, safety and precinct chair training.

<u>Scholarship Update-</u> Patrick Lawson is the chair of the scholarship committee. Maureen will contact committee members Sue Bell-Milbey and Evelyn Griffen to check if they wish to continue to participate on the committee. Committee members will discuss the scholarship program and scholarship criteria and present the criteria at the January monthly meeting.
